

ORDINANCE # 554

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 2002-1 AND AMENDING SECTION 204 OF ARTICLE 1 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ST. FRANCIS, KANSAS, AND ESTABLISHING THE NUMBER OF COUNCILMEMBERS-ELECT NECESSARY TO CONSTITUTE A QUORUM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ST. FRANCIS, KANSAS, that Charter Ordinance No. 2001-1 requiring that four of the five councilmembers-elect constitute a quorum is hereby repealed and Section 204 of Article 1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

1-204. SAME; QUORUM. In all cases, it shall require a majority of the councilmembers-elect to constitute a quorum to do business.

This amendment to the 2003 Code of the City of St. Francis, Kansas shall be effective upon its publication in the St. Francis Herald.
